

CODE OF CONDUCT

JetLev

For your safety and the safety of others, the following rules will be enforced at all times whenever JetLev activities are taking place:

1. No one under the age of 18 years old is permitted to ride or operate the JetLev.
2. Only one person at a time, no tandem rides.
3. You must be able to operate a motorized device.
4. No one will be permitted to operate the JetLev if they are determined to be intoxicated, under the influence of alcohol or any narcotic, or under the influence of any medication, prescribed or over-the-counter, to the extent that the person's ability to operate the JetLev may be impaired.
5. You must be able to be properly fitted into the harness, as determined by the JetLev instructor and assistant.
6. If you had surgery recently such that your balance or ability to operate or control the JetLev may be impaired, you may not operate the JetLev.
7. No horseplay or rough play – and please, no swearing.
8. Be sure to stay at least 500 feet away from anything that may be in the water when you are.
9. Do not dive off the boards or from the boat into the water, as the area may be shallow.
10. Be careful when stepping off the boards into the water, as the depth of the water may differ from location to location.
11. In order to participate in this activity, you must always follow the instructions of the JetLev instructor and assistant. Anyone not following the rules will be asked to leave without a refund.

Things to Wear

1. All JetLev operators must wear a lifejacket and proper swimwear at all times. You will get wet.
2. All personal items, such as floats, watches, earrings, necklaces, etc., should be removed prior to operating the JetLev
