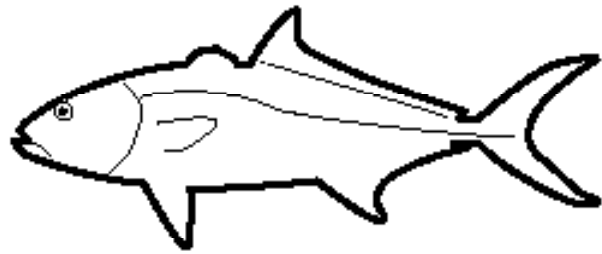

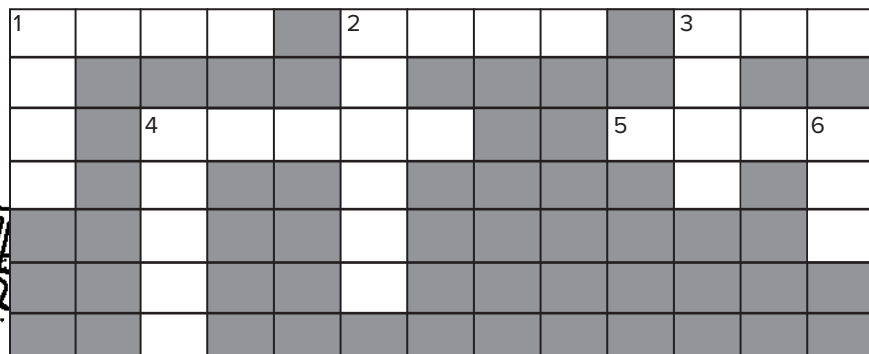

Crossword Puzzle

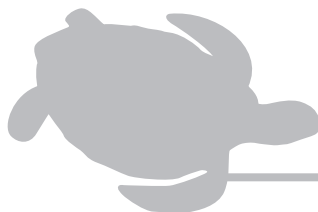


Across

6. Keeps the sun off your head

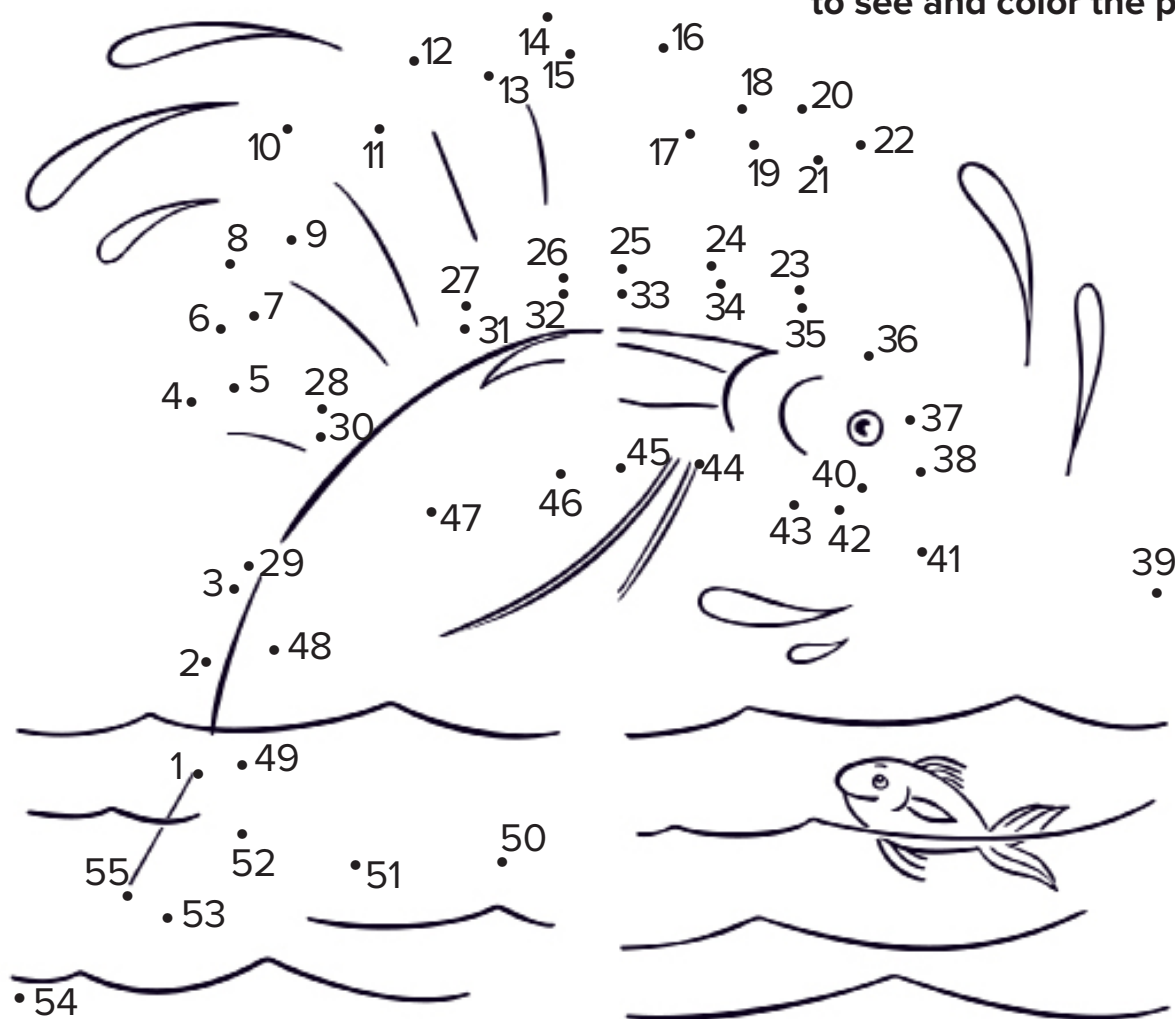


Fun Facts

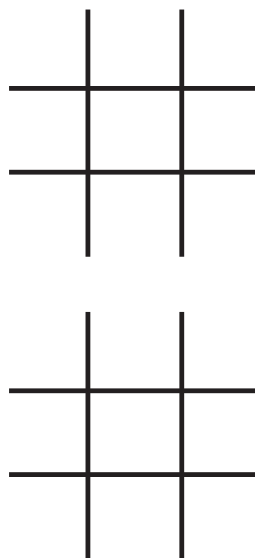
- Florida beaches are home to 80 percent of loggerhead turtles in the U.S.A.

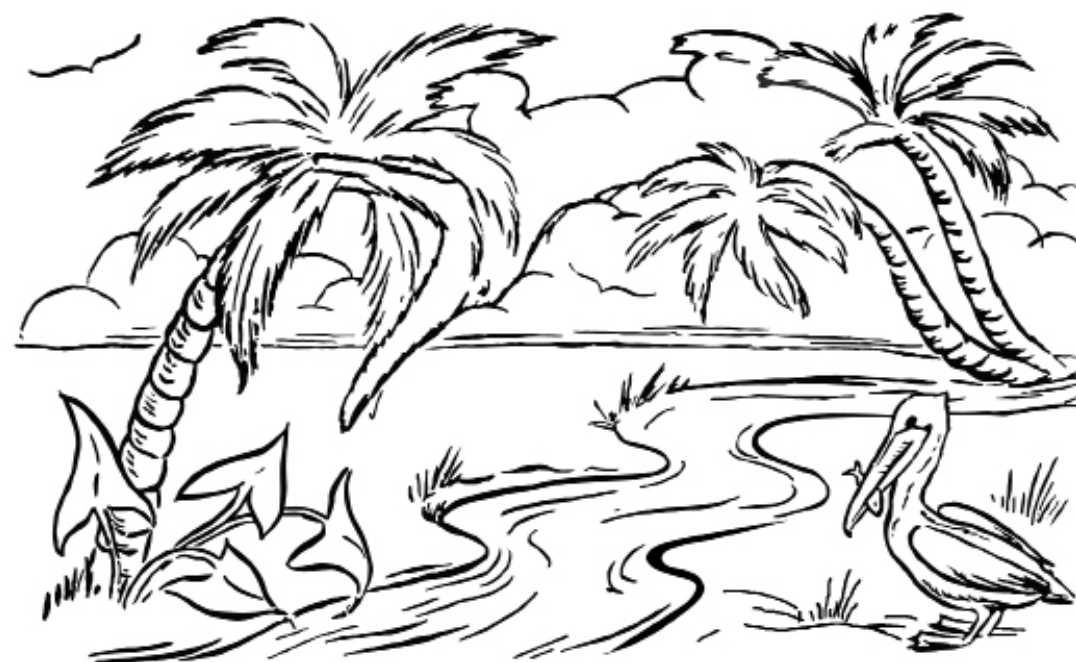
